Love is a Verb: A study of I John, A Bible study, led by John Frye. Mennonite Church USA encourages the study of 1 John as a lead up to the 2017 Convention theme "Love is a Verb". In Christ, we see that love is something lived, love is active in the world, love is a verb.
