## **Announcements:**

- **Summer Worship Time Change** – In **June, July & August**, there is **no Sunday School**; Sunday worship services will begin at **10:00 a.m.**

- **Pre-budget Conversation** - Your Stewardship Commission (June A, Dennis B, Lowell M & AI R) will host a Pre-Budget Conversation **Sunday, June 25, 9:00–9:45 AM**. Come and help us peer into the future. We value your input before we begin to formulate the church budget for next year; all input will be welcome.
- **Mennonite Disaster Service (MDS) needs volunteers!** MDS is building bridges in West Virginia that meet the West Virginia state expectations for a personal bridge of an approved family. Volunteers assist in the wood construction, painting, ecological landscaping around the bridge area, some heavy equipment operation, and placing the bridge in its permanent location. The primary need each week is a skilled track hoe operator, 6 energetic persons to provide physical labor, and a cook for each week.
