Announcements:

- **Summer Worship Time** – In July & August, Sunday School does not meet. Sunday worship services begin at **10:00 a.m.**
- **7% Giving - Matching Gifts** - A generous, anonymous donor will match additional gifts designated for 7% Giving up to \$3,000. This additional money would be given to the fourteen 2016-17 entities in the same proportion as used with 2016-17 **7% Giving**. (This is **not** additional money for the 2017-18 entities.) If you would like to make such a contribution: Write "**7% Giving Match**" on the memo line of your check on or before Sunday, July 30. Special gifts, with this match could increase 7% Giving by as much as \$6,000.
- **It is 7% Giving Input time.** RMC allocates 7% of General Fund Contributions among non-profit organizations with which we work and volunteer. This year we have 11 entities on our list! This is to invite your input on how we'll allocate 7% of contributions next year - Sept '17 through Aug '18. All RMC members and regular participants are welcome to participate. Hardcopy scoring sheets are in your mailboxes today. A few hardcopies of the Entity Descriptions are on the "back table." Please submit your Scoring Sheet either electronically or hardcopy to Al Reberg on or before Sunday, August 6
- **Giving Plans** - Each year your Stewardship Commission invites each of us to prepare a confidential estimate of expected financial contributions to RMC during the next fiscal year. Giving Plan Packets for FY 2017-18 were placed in your mailboxes.
- Stewardship Commission reports that **contributions to the RMC General Fund through June**, the first ten months of the fiscal year, **totaled \$132,715**. Note that this is slightly over the budget-projected contributions of \$131,893. In love, let us encourage one another to give as we have been given and ask for God's Spirit to give us the strength and courage to live as maturing stewards.
- **Budget Input** - Your Stewardship Commission (June, Dennis Lowell & Al) is now constructing a proposed budget. Your input is welcome. Contact a member of your Stewardship Commission - - *June A, Dennis B, Lowell M & Al R*
