Children in Worship

Church Creations are designed to complement the day's scripture reading or another worship theme. While Church Creations are designed with children and youth in mind, adults are invited to participate as materials are available.

Hearing Assistance, Accessible Restroom

An accessible, gender-neutral bathroom is available near the front entrance.
