7% Giving - Matching Gifts - A generous, anonymous donor will match additional gifts designated for 7% Giving up to \$3,000. This additional money would be given to the eleven 2017-18 entities in the same proportion as used with 2017-18 **7% Giving**. (This is **not** additional money for the seventeen 2018-19 entities.) If you would like to make such a contribution: Write "**7% Giving Match**" on the memo line of your check on or before **Sunday, August 12**.

The Stewardship Commission reports that **contributions to the RMC General Fund** through June, the tenth month of the fiscal year, totaled \$128,098. This is below the budget-projected contributions of \$138,978.
